



TMRS BOARD SELECTS ERIC HENRY AS NEW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

On April 27, 2007, the TMRS Board of Trustees announced its choice for the new Executive Director of the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS). After a review of six well-qualified candidates from around the country, the Board selected Mr. Eric Henry, Executive Director of the Pennsylvania State Employees' Retirement System (SERS).

Mr. Henry, of Herndon, Pennsylvania, has been the Executive Director of Pennsylvania SERS since 2004 and also served at SERS as Director of Internal Audit and Assistant Executive Director from 1994 to 2000. Before his appointment to Executive Director at SERS, he was Executive Director and Chief Investment Officer for the New Hampshire Retirement System from 2000 to 2004. Mr. Henry holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting from Penn State University and a Master of Business Administration degree from Bucknell University. He is also a Certified Information Systems Auditor and a Certified Public Accountant, and has received the Certificate of Achievement in Public Plan Policy from the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans (IFEPP).

As Executive Director at TMRS, Mr. Henry will implement the Board's policies and manage the future direction of TMRS, a public retirement system with more than 120,000 members in 821 cities. The System pays benefits to more than 27,000 retired Texans and administers a trust fund of over \$14 billion. Mr. Henry will begin his new position effective June 11, 2007.

The TMRS Board of Trustees and the System's staff join together to welcome Mr. Henry and also to thank Mr. Eric W. Davis, Deputy Executive Director, for serving as Interim Executive Director of TMRS during the search for a new Executive Director following the retirement of Mr. Gary W. Anderson in October 2006.
